Write down two things about the exhibit that helped you pick the animal's favorite weather.

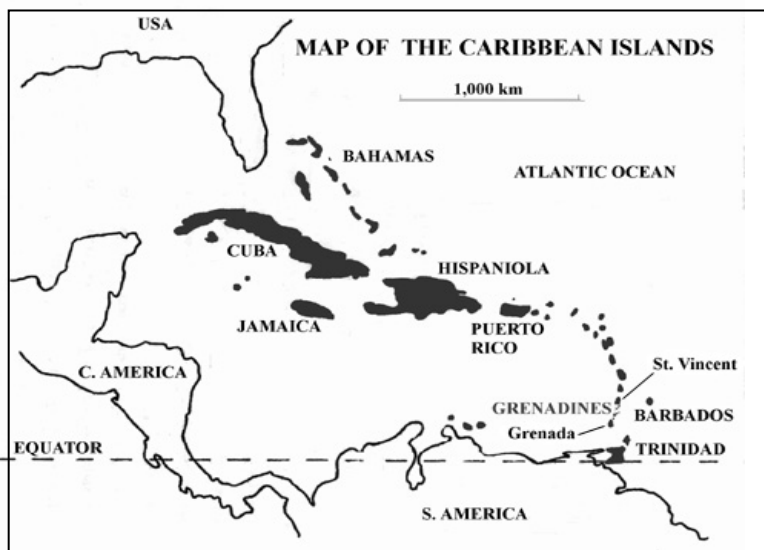
