

I'm Going To the Zoo!

Dear Parents:

Your child's class is scheduled to visit Nashville Zoo on _____.
To make sure your child's visit is enjoyable, please keep the following information in mind.

Payment:

Please make sure your child's total Zoo admission cost (and yours if you plan to attend) is paid to the teacher or group coordinator BEFORE their visit to the Zoo. For your child's class to qualify for the Zoo's group rates, one payment must be made for the entire group. **This also applies to any parents attending with the class. Anyone attempting to make an individual payment at the Zoo's ticket booth will NOT qualify for the group rate.**

Clothing:

Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for a day outside. Have them wear comfortable shoes. Please remember sunscreen and bug-spray when appropriate.

Food:

Check with your child's teacher and find out if they are packing lunches or buying them at the Zoo. If you are packing a lunch, pick items that don't need to be kept cool. Frequently, lunches are left on the bus until lunchtime. Put your child's name on his or her lunch container.

Rules and Regulations:

The following rules and regulations are in place to insure a safe and enjoyable visit for everyone. Please review these rules with your child before entering the Zoo. Nashville Zoo reserves the right to expel any individual or group in violation of these rules.

- Adult chaperones must stay with their group at all times.
- Pets, bicycles, skates, skateboards, balls, roller blades, loud radios, glass containers, and alcohol are prohibited on Zoo grounds.
- Please do not feed the animals or tap on exhibit glass.
- Please do not enter non-public areas.
- Please keep noise to a minimum, especially inside buildings.
- Nashville Zoo is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items.
- Misuse or damage of Zoo property will result in immediate expulsion from the Zoo.
- The padded play area (Tot Lot) in the Jungle Gym is for children under 36" tall.
- Be courteous of smaller children while playing on the Jungle Gym.
